

UPPER OXFORD TOWNSHIP PLANNING COMMISSION
JUNE 1, 2015

The Upper Oxford Township Planning Commission held their regular monthly meeting at the township building, 1185 Limestone Road, Oxford, PA at 7:00 P.M. on Monday, June 1, 2015.

Members present: Christine Nibouar, Sam Reyburn, David Underwood, Harold Bryson and Karl Herr.

Others present: Jane Daggett, Secretary, Charles Fleischmann, Scott Rugen and Clair King.

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman, Christine Nibouar at 7:00 P.M.

MINUTES – Motion was made by Harold Bryson, seconded by Sam Reyburn and carried to approve the May 4, 2015 Minutes. MOTION CARRIED.

CLAIR KING/FORTUGNA PROPERTY – Mr. King presented a sketch plan to the Planning Commission. Mr. King is interested in purchasing approximately 30 acres from the Alfred Fortugna property. Mr. King would like to add the purchased property eventually to the Agricultural Preservation Board. Mr. Gene Fortugna has been in contact with Concord Land Planners to survey and draw up formal, add-on subdivision plans.

OXFORD REGION PLANNING COMMITTEE – The Supervisor gave the Planning Commission a list of Top Priorities from the Oxford Region Planning Committee for them to review and rank in order of what they consider importance. There are different categories which we must begin implementation. Scott Rugen gave some examples to the Planning Commission. Papers are due before the next Oxford Region meeting which will be June 24th at Lower Oxford Township building. Scott also informed the Planning Commission that speaker, David Ross will be giving a lecture on the Serpentine Barrens and all are invited to attend. Scott and Charlie both stressed identifying and recognizing the seriousness and importance of water quality and storm water management. Charlie also mentioned the danger of pipelines and that we should be incorporating this into our planning. The Supervisors plan on holding work sessions in the future regarding items of concerns. Christine, Dave and Karl filled out their papers and handed in to the Secretary to pass along to the Supervisors.

ADJOURNMENT – There being no further business, motion was made by Karl Herr, seconded by Harold Bryson and carried to adjourn at 8:00 P.M.
